PRIVACY NOTICE RELATING TO MEMBER DATA

Keeping your information safe and secure is the club's top priority. This privacy notice explains what the Gritstone Club does with the personal data that it collects from members and outlines Club member's rights concerning that data. The Club's data protection policy is written to comply with the GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) which was introduced on 25/5/19.

The Gritstone Club's use of your personal information

The Club holds the personal information that you have given on the Membership Application Form (new members) or that it already holds on record (old members). This information is held in a secure cloud based system and in the MSO secure membership online service, run by the BMC.

This information is used in order to carry out activities associated with the normal running of the club. This includes:

- Completing the membership application process.
- Collecting the annual subscription.
- Providing you with general Club communications. These include but are not limited to:
 - o Regular newsletters to keep you informed of club matters.
 - Notices of forthcoming club events.
 - o Inviting you to join the cloud based data storage system.
- Publishing an annual Gritstone Club handbook containing members' details to include name, address, e-mail and telephone numbers. This is published on the secure members only cloud based file system and is available to be viewed by all members.
 - Members may opt out of having their details published in the handbook (although their name will still appear in the book).
- Providing data to the BMC (British Mountaineering Council) as the umbrella organisation for our sport. The BMC will provide you with BMC Club Membership which gives you:
 - o 3rd party insurance when involved in activities on the hills.
 - Discounts at various shops.
- Your name (but not contact details) may appear in articles produced by the Club that are available in the public domain e.g. on the Club website or in the Club Journal.

What the Club does not do with your data

The Club does not:

- Pass on member data to any third party organisation or individual (except to the BMC).
- Carry out any automated decision making or profiling based on members' data.
- Hold any 'sensitive personal data' on members as defined by the GDPR.

Storage of your personal information

The personal information about Club members is securely stored on the MSO (Membership Services Online) system run by the BMC.

The club will hold your personal data on the MSO for as long as you are a member of the club. If you leave the club, your data will be removed from the MSO after one year from the last date of your membership.

Your rights regarding your personal data

As a data subject, you have the right to request access the personal data that the Club holds on you. If there are any mistakes in that information, you have the right to have the mistakes corrected.

Complaints or queries

If you think that the Club's collection or use of information is unfair, misleading or inappropriate please contact the Club as detailed below. The club is also happy to provide any additional information or explanation about out data protection policy.
